How to prepare your laboratory for a hurricane

CHEMICAL SAFETY

- x Label and cap all chemical containers including waste containers.
 - x Remove all chemicals from bench top.

 - o Move chemicals to windowless rooms, or away from exterior windows.

Laboratory supervisors are responsible for protecting their own equipment and research. It is imperative that personnel prepare and be able to secure their areas. These preparations, as well as maintaining a stockpile of critical supplies, will minimize loss of research and equipment damage in the event of a hurricane.
