The mission of the USF School of Social Work is to prepare graduates to achieve excellence as professionals and leaders in social work practice, research and education. We are committed to graduating students who reflect the School's commitment to promoting social and economic justice, and sustainable human and community well being for all.

Appointment to the full time faculty of the School of Social Work requires at a minimum, possession of a Master's degree in Social Work from a CSWE accredited graduate program or a DSW or PhD in Social Work. All faculty members eligible for appointment to a tenure earning or tenured line must possess a DSW or Ph.D. in Social Work/Social Welfare or a related field ~~or~~ degree in social work with two years practice experience.
