This is a very simple problem. The first step is to identify the variables and their relationships. In this case, we have variables A , B , C , and D . The relationships are given by the equations above. We can start by solving for A in terms of B and C .

From the first equation, we have $A - CA = A - B$. This can be rearranged to $A - CA - A = -B$, which simplifies to $-CA = -B$. Multiplying both sides by -1 gives $CA = B$.

From the second equation, we have $A + D = C$. This can be rearranged to $A = C - D$.

Substituting $A = C - D$ into the first equation, we get $(C - D) - C(C - D) = C - D - B$. This simplifies to $C - D - C^2 + CD = C - D - B$.
