## MSEM Program Admission Requirements

### Admission Deadlines

Fall:	February 15
Spring:	September 15
Summer:	January 15

### Admission Minimum Requirements

1. A baccalaureate of science degree in Engineering from a regionally accredited institution. Other baccalaureate of science degrees in technical fields may be accepted on an individual basis.
2. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 out of a possible 4.0 for all undergraduate work taken during the last two years of the applicant's studies.
3. GRE is required with minimum scores of 156 for quantitative and 146 for verbal. GRE may be waived for Accelerated Program applicants.
4. English Language Proficiency<sup>1</sup>: International prospective students are required to have a minimum score on the TOEFL iBT score of 79.
5. A resume and a letter of recommendation.
6. At least 2 years of work experience in engineering or management. Otherwise, one or two semesters of internship may be required.

### Financial Aid

The department does not provide financial support (including graduate, teaching, or research assistantships) or tuition waivers to master's students.

The TOEFL requirement can be waived by the Admissions Office if an applicant has earned a baccalaureate or higher degree at a regionally accredited institution in the U.S. or a baccalaureate degree at a foreign institution where language of instruction was English (must be noted on the official transcript).
