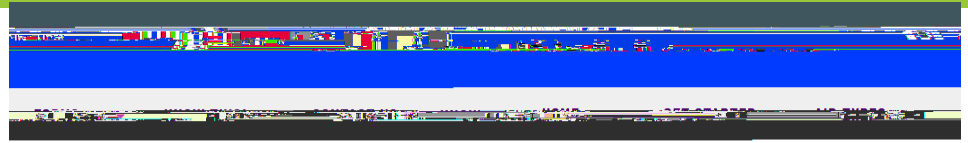

# Confidentiality & Privacy of Financial Aid Records

Only a custodial parent listed on the FAFSA may receive financial aid information about the student. Students must complete the Financial Aid Privacy Release form for Dependent Students

Additional authentication questions to confirm both the student and parent identity each time we are contacted by phone

This is a separate federal regulation than FERPA & different than the Student Records Access Authorization form used by the Office of the Registrar, Office of Admissions and Student Accounting Services!

# Do We Have Your FAFSA?

If you submitted your FAFSA more than two weeks ago and included USF as a school,

1. Log into [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) to make sure there no errors
2. Check your USF email. If any of the above do not match your

system, we will be unable to download your FAFSA

Prior to beginning classes: contact the Office of Admissions

After beginning classes: contact the Office of the Registrar

3. May also affect receipt of Florida Bright Futures & Florida Pre-Paid

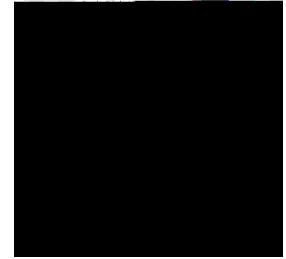

# Submit Your Final Transcripts

In order for your financial aid to be paid, you must submit your final college transcripts to the Office of Admissions before the start of classes



## Is there an easy way to figure out how much it costs to attend USF?

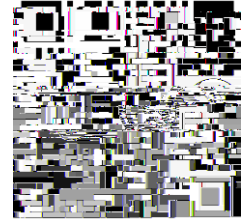
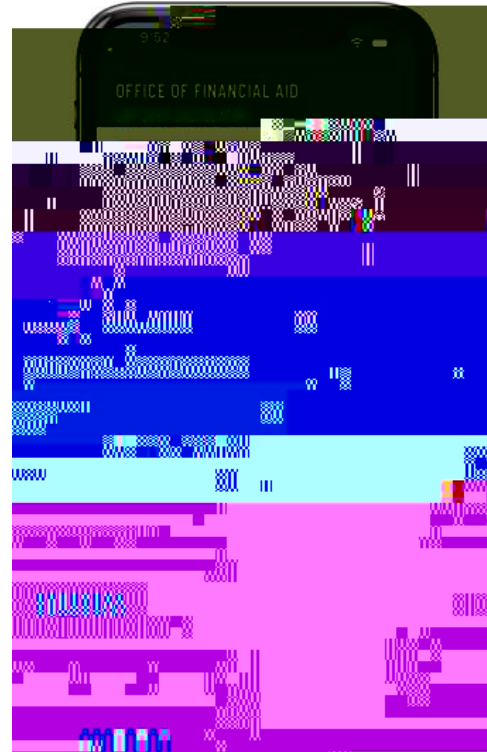
Yes, use our **Cost Calculator!**

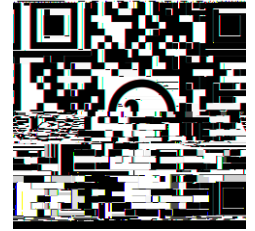
It will estimate your bill before payments are due

## Do I have to do all the math?

Nope! Just enter all of your costs and let the calculator do the rest!





\_\_\_\_\_ is a Federal regulation and must be met each semester  
Some aid programs cannot be paid if students are not meeting SAP requirements

\_\_\_\_\_ : earning a bachelor's degree in less than 180 hours attempted over the entire college career (including courses from other schools)

\_\_\_\_\_ : having a 2.0 USF GPA by the time you are in junior standing

\_\_\_\_\_ : completing at least 67% of the courses enrolled in each semester (including courses from other schools)

SAP is calculated at the end of every semester. Check your SAP status in Student Self-Service regularly

A tuition payment deferment prevents cancellation of registration for non-payment of fees, and temporarily prevents assessment of late payment fees

Tuition not paid by the **Payment Date** will be assessed a late payment fee and have a cash collection hold placed on the student account by Student Accounting Services

If you are an on-campus housing resident and a USF meal plan recipient, the payment deferment due date in Student Self-Service will serve as your payment due date for tuition/fees, housing and meal plan charges each semester

# What is the BAPP & How do I qualify?



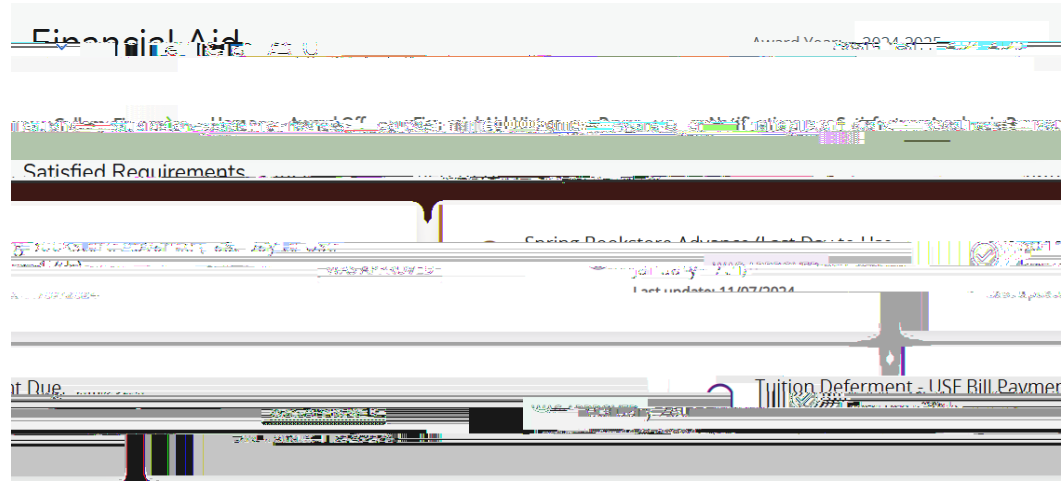
Allows eligible students to purchase textbooks & supplies (at a USF campus bookstore) prior to the first day of classes using financial aid before it is paid

Be enrolled at least half-time (6 credit hours) in USF hours; and

Have financial aid that is at least \$100 more than your bill

Check OASIS and your USF email

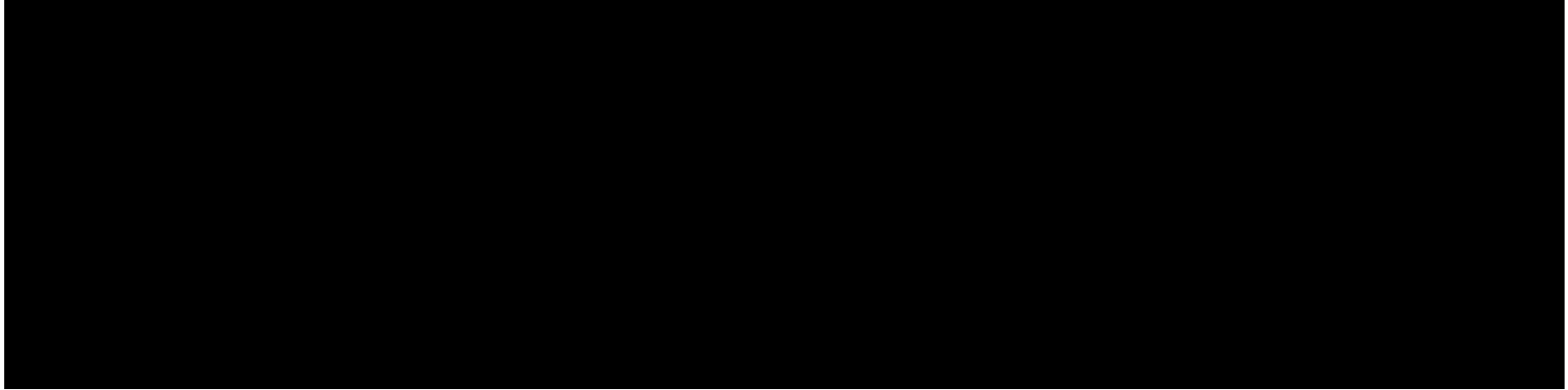

Students should confirm they have a \_\_\_\_\_ amount in OASIS. If amount is

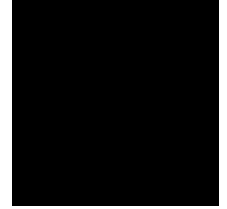








# Florida Pre-Paid & Bright Futures

Any excess would be refunded to the student

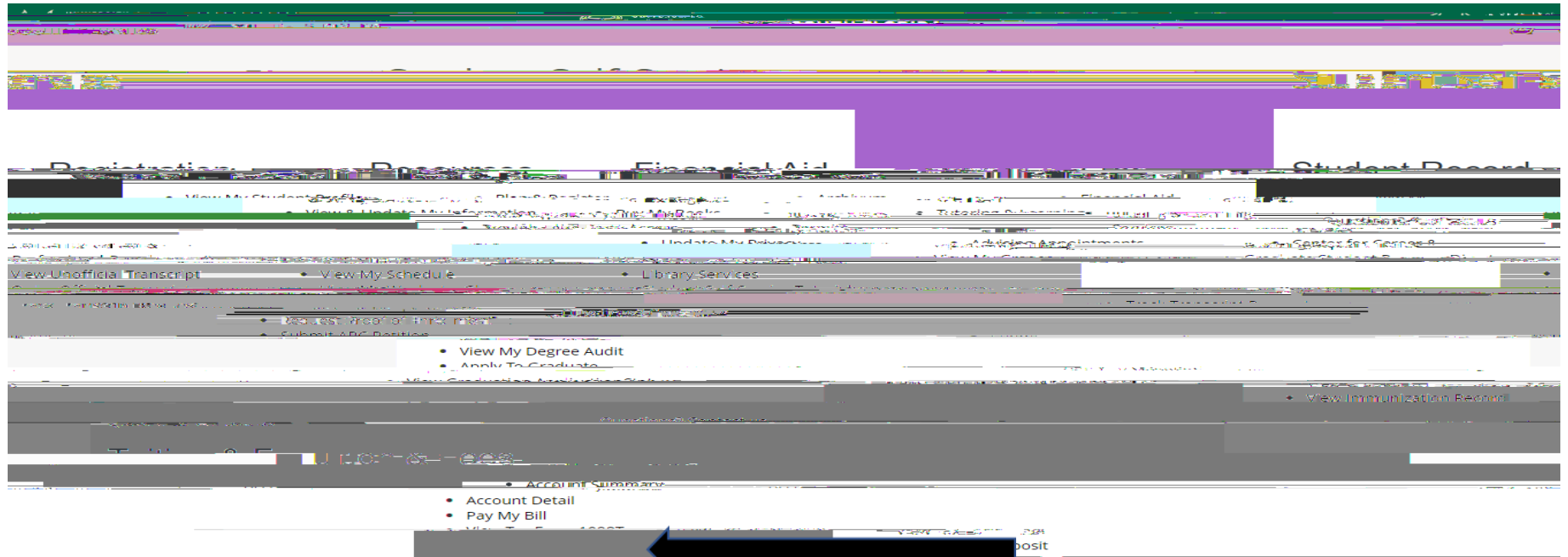
You will need to notify Student Financial Services if you DO NOT want to use your Florida Pre-Paid

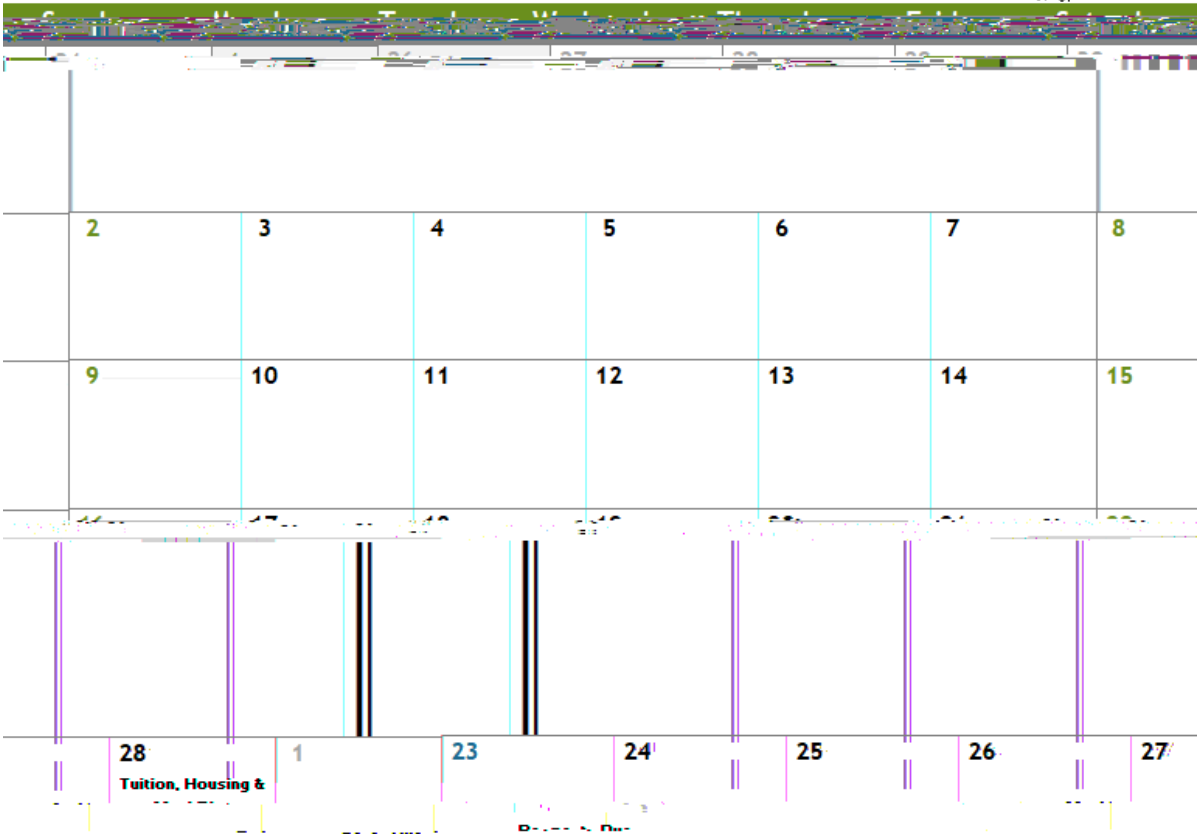

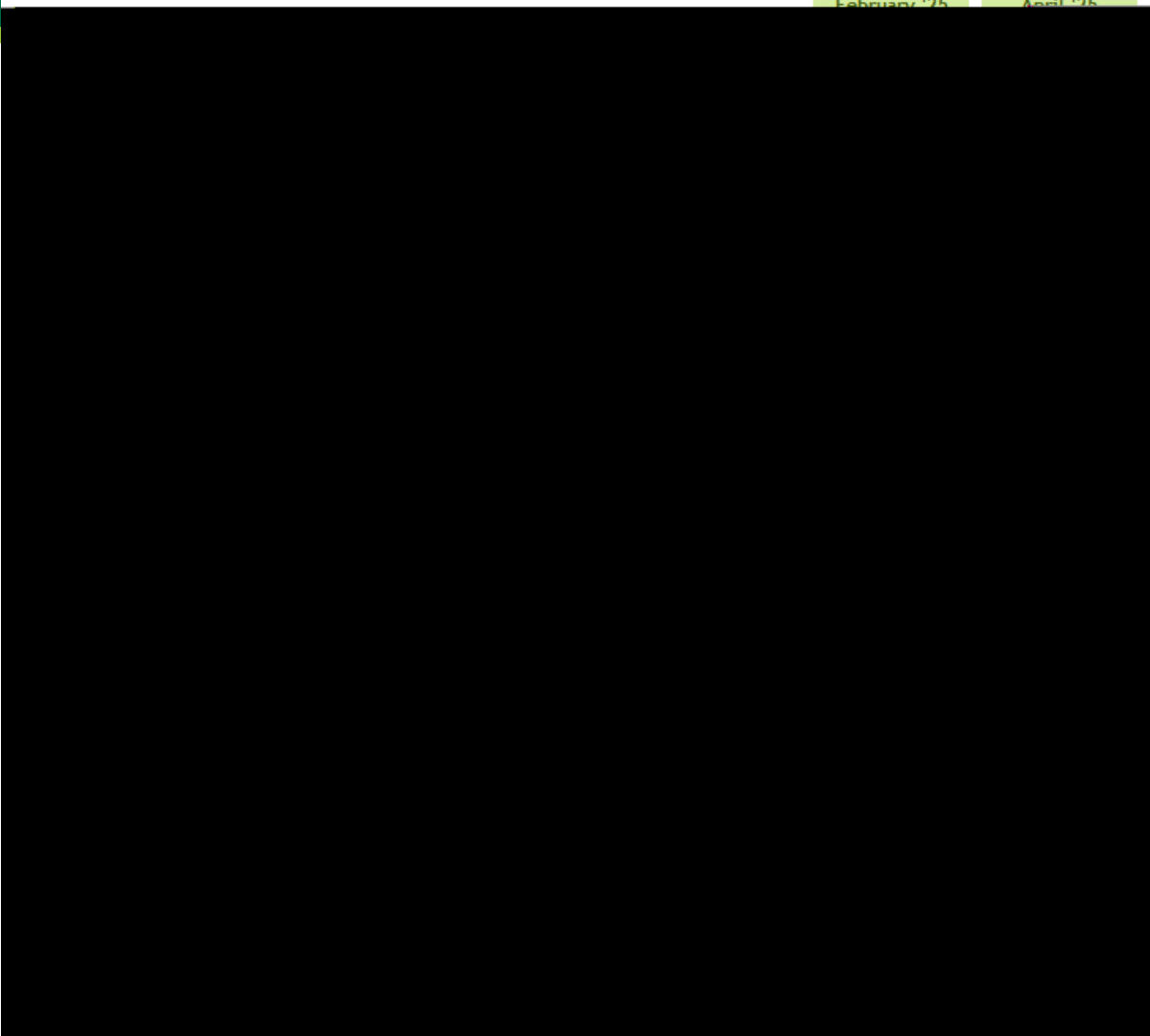
