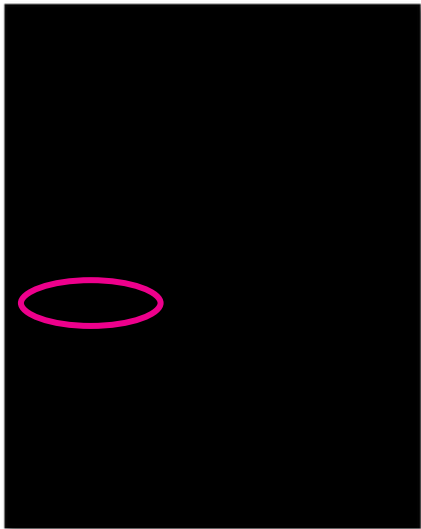
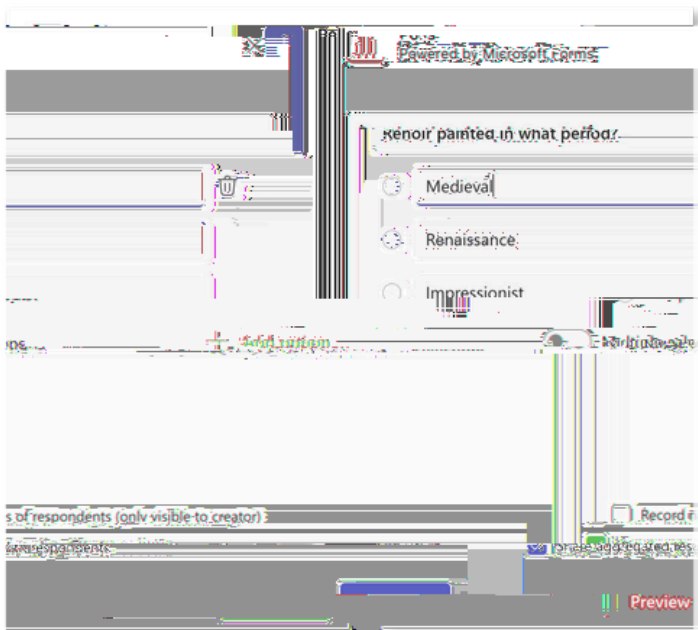

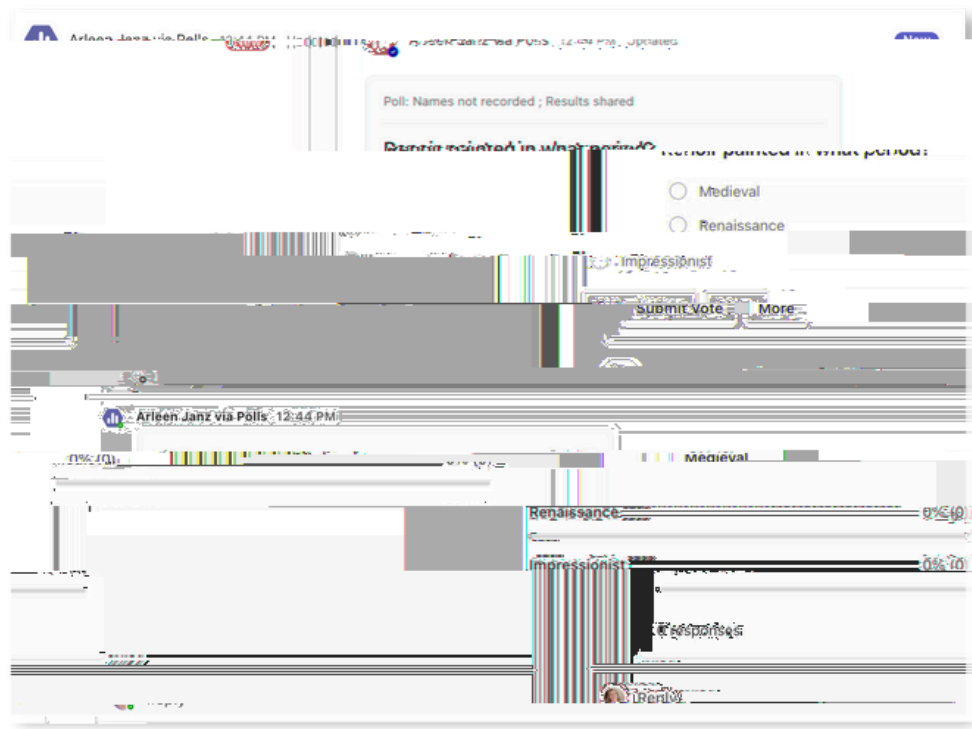

The poll will appear in the channel as a new post that people can reply to. If you allowed the results to be shared in the edit screen, you will see those as well.

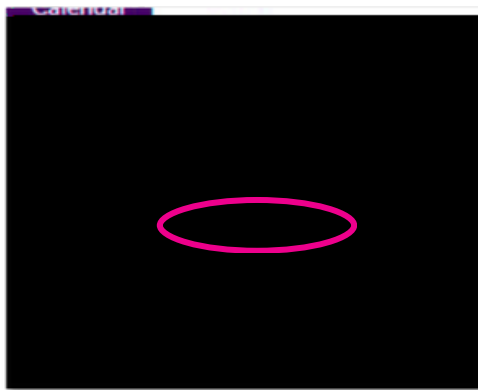

Using collaborative documents is a great way to get students to work together and improve their social learning skills throughout the session. Use cases include group lectures, group presentations, and courses and notes.

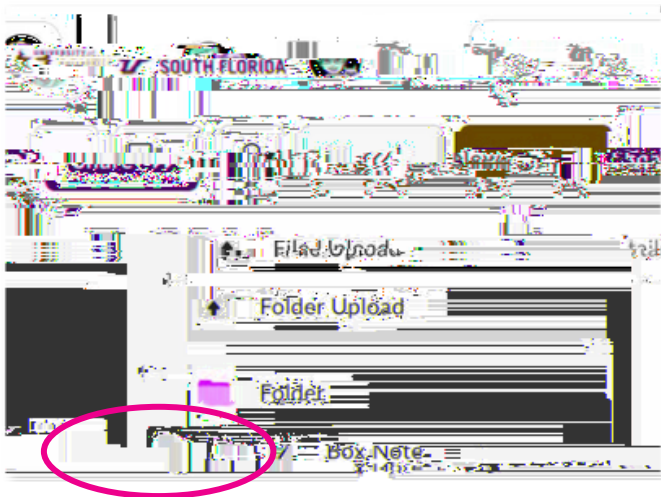
OneVote offers great functionality for students to create notes and collaborate with University of South Florida students, making it easy for faculty to get students to work collaboratively.

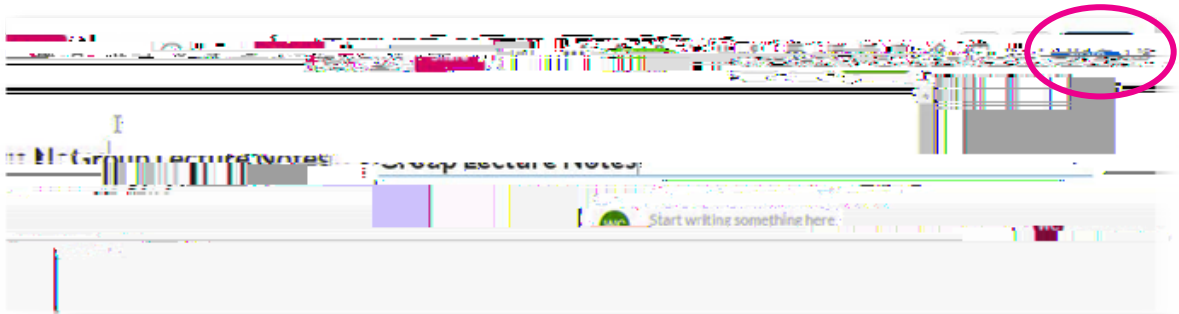

Next, select the **New** and the **Box Note** from the dropdown that appears.



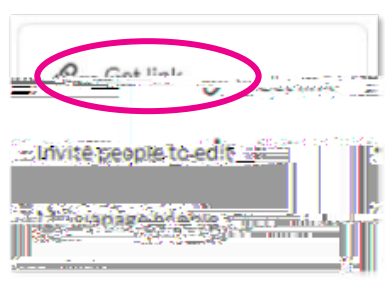

Once the OneVote interface appears, title the document and select the **Share** button to get the link to share this document with our students.



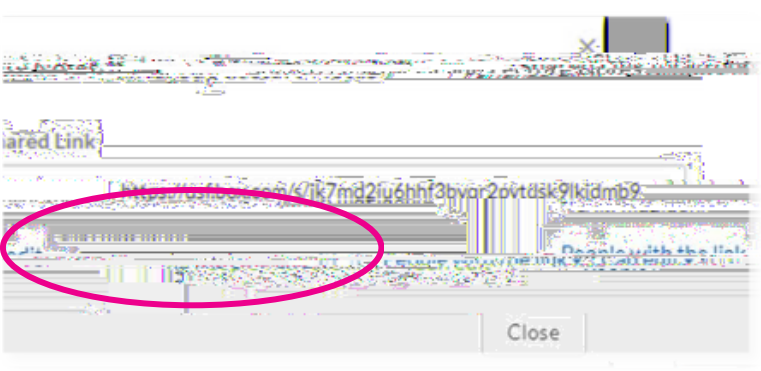

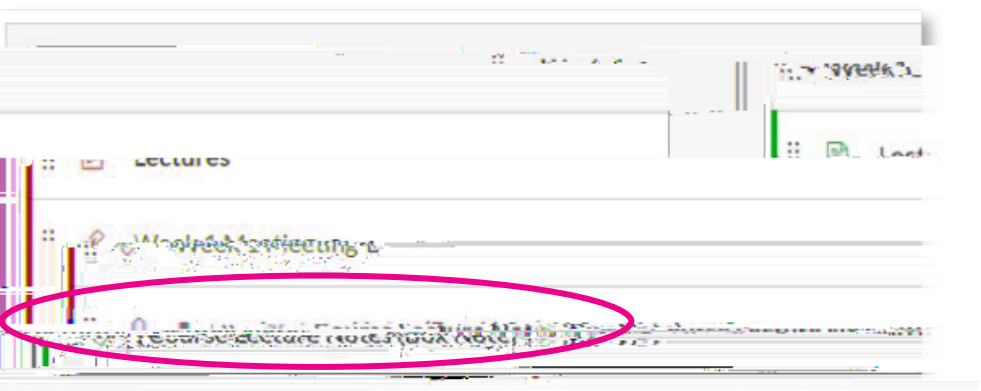
