

22CFR41.112 (d) provides for the automatic extension of the validity of non-immigrant visas after a temporary visit to the United States if certain conditions are met:

The temporary visit must be for 30 days or less.

The person must have a valid unexpired admission stamp or paper I-94.

The current visa status (F-1/J-1/H1-B) continues to be valid. Proof includes the I-20, DS-2019, or I-129.

The visit did not include countries outside of contiguous territory or adjacent islands.

The person is not a citizen of the countries designated by the US as a [state sponsor of terrorism](#)
